## Steps:

1. Isolate water, and air from the system. This can be done by turning the circled valve perpendicular to the lines they are on.

6. Inspect the Hydra-flex Cannon's seals for damage.





7. Replace any damaged seals or components.

- 8. Reassemble the Hydra-Flex Cannon and Hydra-Flex Manifold.
- 9. Restore water and air to the system. This can be done by turning the valves back to parallel.
