

Blower Housing Installation Instructions

Step 1: Remove intake screen or blast gate from old housing along with the blower nozzle. These items will all need to be reused on the new housing.

Step 2: Remove old blower housing - there will be screws that attach the housing to the back plate - loosen screws and remove housing.

Step 3: Mount new housing to the back plate. The new housing will have a steel ring on the inner ring of the housing, this is the back side to be mounted to the back plate. New hardware is provided.

Step 4: Mount intake screen or blast gate - you will need to reuse the hardware. This will get mounted to the side without the steel ring.

Step 5: Install blower nozzle - reuse existing nozzle and install onto housing.

Step 6: Install nozzle pins - we have provided 2 bolts that will need to be installed through the nozzle and housing.

- Drill hole
- Slide bolt in
- Tighten washer and nut
- Make sure to install as high up on the nozzle as possible this should go through the nozzle and housing.



Nozzle is not pictured – make sure these bolts go through both the nozzle and housing.

This is to prevent any debris from exiting the nozzle.
